Home Service for Seniors

The four steps of the Living Connected program are:

1. Meeting with the client to determine their social needs, computer experience and home circumstances in order to develop a personalised plan.
2. Overseeing the purchase and set up of the recommended technology and Internet for this client
3. Learning the basics with a few 1 on 1 home lessons.
4. Providing ongoing help when they get stuck or want to learn more

Aim: to train people to deliver all phases of the Living Connected Program.

Helpers' Workshop

Covers: Step 4 of the LC Program

Aim: to train Living Connected or aged-care home service providers as well as community volunteers who are matched with an older person to provide ongoing basic support when using IT.
